Play Meadow: A meeting took place at the end of August which was poorly attended. At the meeting the Ingham Social Club were present and it was agreed that they would assist the village with fundraising as long as support from the village for their events. Clrs Dawson and Dawson volunteered to help at sale trail and 4 councillors supported the social club quiz night. A further meeting is planned for October 2nd at the church 7pm.

John Milward has secured a choir and organ recital for May 2019 to raise funds and has volunteered to pay for the event and refreshments as his parting gift. All councillors present acknowledged and thanked him for his generosity.

Three quotes have been received and now planning permission can progress. The next meeting will discuss the project and a phased approach to achieving what the village desires. The quotes range from a basic structure on grass to Muga with artificial surface and other play equipment. The costs vary considerably and the group must prioritise and decide what is achievable. Fund raising ideas will be discussed and agreed.
